Trauma and Bleeding Module Study Points

General

Burns

Nontraumatic Hemorrhagic Conditions

- Treatment of post tonsillectomy hemorrhage
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of hemoptysis
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of gastrointestinal hemorrhage
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of hematuria
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of vaginal bleeding in pregnancy

Blood and Component Replacement

- Complications from blood transfusions
- Reversing anticoagulants
- Treatment of hemorrhage in trauma patient taking anticoagulants
- Indications for autotransfusion in patients with hemothorax

Miscellaneous

- Facial nerve blocks
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of high voltage electrical injuries
- Treatment of conducted electrical weapon exposure
- Diagnostic evaluation and treatment of needle stick injuries
- Treatment of mammal bites
- Treatment of frostbite
- Treatment of hemorrhage in trauma patients taking antidepressants
- Treatment of genitourinary infections
