1. Medical resuscitation

### Diagnostic and Therapeutic Procedures

1. Abdominal and gastrointestinal
  - a. Paracentesis
2. Cardiovascular and Thoracic
  - a. Cardiac pacing
  - b. Cardioversion
  - c. Defibrillation
  - d. Pericardiocentesis
  - e. Thoracostomy  
(including small bore catheters)
3. Cutaneous
  - a. Wound closure
4. Head, Ear, Eye, Nose, and Throat
  - a. Control of epistaxis
  - b. Laryngoscopy
  - c. Slit lamp examination
5. Musculoskeletal
  - a. Arthrocentesis
  - b. Fracture/Dislocation immobilization techniques
  - c. Spine immobilization techniques
6. Nervous system
  - a. Lumbar puncture
7. Obstetrics and gynecology
  - a. Delivery of newborn

### Anesthesia and Acute Pain Management

1. Regional anesthesia
  - a. Hematoma block

### Vascular Access

### Airway Techniques

1. Intubation
  - a. Direct laryngoscopy

2. Airway adjuncts
  - a. Use of an LMA
3. Surgical airway
4. Non-invasive ventilatory management
  - a. CPAP/BiPAP
  - b. High flow oxygen
  - c. Pediatric and Adult Bag Valve Mask Ventilation
